Brush up your Irish in Canberra

Spend the Australia Day long weekend learning Irish in the nation's capital

The inaugural Scoil Teanga Canberra 2016 is a long (Australia Day) weekend of Irish language and 'craic' (fun).

Who should come?

Anyone who wants to improve their Irish language skills.

The school is open to adults from across Australia:

- complete newcomers to the Irish language
- those who want to improve their Irish, for example those who learned it at school
- fluent speakers who want to meet to converse in Irish and to help others learn.

Classes for every level

There are classes at five levels to suit the Irish language skills of the participants.

Level 1 (beginners)

People with no prior knowledge of Irish or who have been studying for less than one year.

Level 2 (continuing)

Students who have now completed level 1 or who have studied Irish at some earlier stage in the past, for example at school.

Level 3 (intermediate)

Students who have been studying for at least two years and who are now approaching the conversation stage.

Level 4 (advanced)

Generally, those who are comfortable for the entire lesson to be conducted in Irish.

Level 5 (comhrá)

A special conversation class under the leadership of Barney Devlin

The craic

Other Irish activities provide a break in a friendly atmosphere. These include the official opening, table quiz, guest speaker, concert, singing, tin whistle, music and dance. Informal sessions continue into the wee small hours. Come and join the fun.
