The Scoil Gheimhridh Sydney 2012 is a long weekend of Irish language and craic. Come and improve your Irish language skills.

The key activity of the weekend is Irish language classes. Other Irish activities provide a break in a convivial environment. These include the official opening, table quiz, guest speaker, concert and classes in poetry, singing, tin whistle, yoga or dance. Informal sessions continue into the wee small hours. Come and join the fun.

The school is open to adults from across Australia:

- complete newcomers to the Irish language
- those who want to improve their Irish, for example those who learnt it at school
- fluent people who want to meet to converse in Irish and to help others learn.

There are classes at five levels to suit the Irish language skills of the participants. There are three language classes per day on Saturday and Sunday plus an informal class on Monday morning.

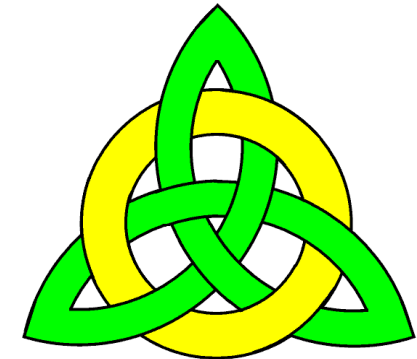

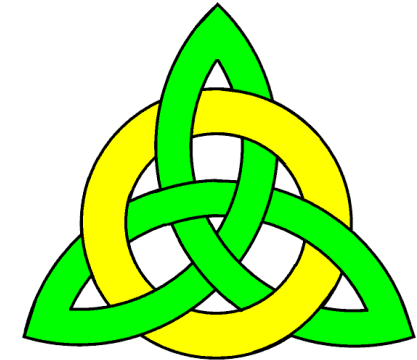
